



G.S. Barnes Scholarship Fund of The Oregon Community Foundation

The scholarship was established in 2017 by G.S. Barnes to support Black or African heritage students pursuing college. The scholarship is for graduating seniors from Roosevelt, Parkrose, and David Douglas high schools in Portland. One student will be selected each year to receive a 4-year scholarship, contingent on meeting annual academic criteria.

CRITERIA

- Graduating seniors from Roosevelt, Parkrose, and David Douglas High Schools.
- Planning to enroll fulltime (at least 12 credits) at a public 4-year college or university in Oregon.
- Must fill out the FAFSA or ORSAA and demonstrate financial need.
- Automatically renewed each year for a maximum of four years. Annual renewal application required.
- Cumulative high school GPA between a 3.0 to 3.4.
