

April 2021 Program Summary Report



Summary of 2019-21 Programming (click header for full summary)

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, chapter programming had restricted programming. The total number of individuals served over the two year program period is 468; 153 males, 311 females. Out of the **468 served**, 421 were African American. The total spent on programs is \$19,040 in which \$17,000 went towards **13 scholarships awards**. This total excludes COVID-19 facet donations made after submission of the program report to national.

20-21 Umbrella Summary - NextGenLead! (click header for full summary)

Interdisciplinary facet teams planned a workshop series designed to develop community leadership competencies across facet areas in our next generation of women leaders. Workshops were to begin in October 2020 with a culminating event to be held in March 2021. Participants were to showcase their leadership skills by designing and launching a **"Rock Your Power" campaign** through social media. Due to challenges faced by the COVID-19 pandemic, our umbrella program has been postponed until further notice. As a result, there were no other facet activities outside of HHS.

20-21 Health & Human Services Summary - Facet Program (click header for full summary)

Health and Human Services maintained their award winning programming in partnership with multiple community partners to sustain health services and supports during the COVID-19 health pandemic. The facet facilitated activities each month throughout the year, which included our **75 Million Steps Challenge** in addition to their **annual A6 event**. All events were conducted virtually.
